

COVID SHUTDOWN

Remote Learning

Dear parent/caregiver,

Today the Premier announced a 7-day statewide lockdown starting at 6.00pm tonight (Tuesday 20 July).

Wednesday 21 July will be a pupil free day. Only the children of essential workers and vulnerable children will be able to attend school. A skeleton staff will provide supervision but not a learning program for tomorrow.

We will be providing a remote learning program from Thursday 22 July. Students will be required to visit DayMap at the start of each scheduled lesson (including Home Group) and follow the instructions their teacher has left for that lesson. DayMap shows when and for how long each student has visited the lesson. Their teacher *may* also request the class to participate in an on-line DayMap conversation or meet via TEAMS during this time, and *may* request work to be submitted via DayMap.

All students have been asked to take home their laptops/devices, books and anything else they need to continue their learning from home. If your child has technical difficulties with accessing DayMap or any of the Microsoft Suite needed in classes, please email our support staff on: dl.0965.ictadmin@schools.sa.edu.au . This email will be monitored during school hours.

All South Australians are making sacrifices to ensure our community remains as safe as possible. We appreciate that this is a significant undertaking for you and your family. Your child's teacher, our support staff and I are here to support you where we can. Please take care of yourselves and your loved ones and hopefully we will see everyone back at school (pending any further announcements from the Premier) on Wednesday of next week.
