Principal's Report:

- 2019 Results: NAPLAN: best results since started recording, 7% higher that state average for upper progress reading, 15% higher than state average for Upper progress numeracy, Underdale students are progressing faster than the rest of the state.
- PAT-R and PAT-M: Part of our SIP as we can monitor all year levels in middle school.
- SACE results: 98.7% successfully completed SACE, higher than state average. Over 95% of our grades were passes, 31 students completed VET certificates, 22pf which were of certificate 3 level, 40 students achieved an ATAR. 38 got offers, the majority their first preferences.
- Enrolments increasing steadily, with this year being our biggest year 8 enrolment in many years.
