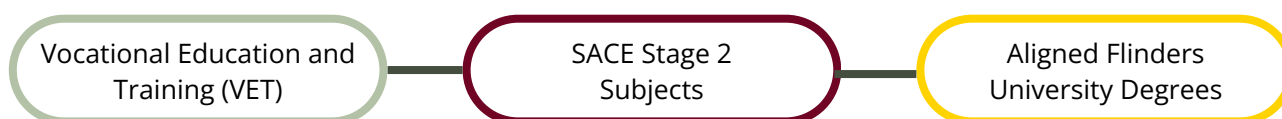
Flinders Aligned

Connected Learning. Clear Pathways.



- Co-designed pathway program developed between the school and Flinders University
- Recognises SACE completion through a combination of SACE Stage 2 subjects and Vocational Education and Training (VET) as strong preparation for university study
- Acknowledges the transferable capabilities that are embedded in VET undertaken by school students
- Provides clear, aligned pathways into selected Flinders degrees

Flinders Aligned connects three key stages of learning:



Students may also have the opportunity to incorporate university level study through Flinders Extension Studies Program as part of their aligned pathway (subject to successful application).

Through careful alignment, students who complete SACE through specific combinations of VET qualification and Stage 2 school subjects can be eligible for guaranteed entry into selected Flinders degrees, subject to meeting any additional Flinders course specific entry requirements (e.g. portfolio, audition, etc).

Each pathway:

- Identifies which VET qualifications and Stage 2 school subjects align with particular degrees
- Recognises VET as meaningful preparation, not an alternative or add-on
- Provides transparent entry requirements, so students know where they are heading.

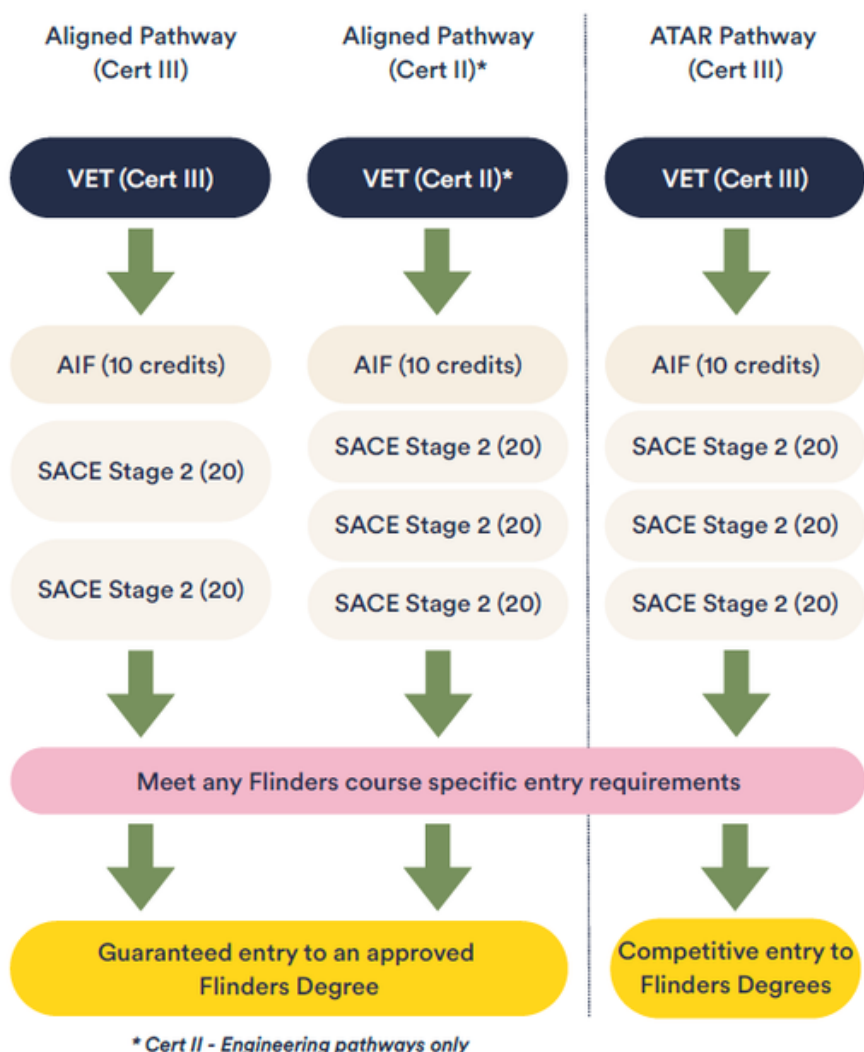
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- **To be eligible, students must successfully:**

- Complete the South Australian Certificate of Education (SACE)
- Complete the required Certificate II or III course (Year 11 or 12)
- Complete the specified Stage 2 subjects (as detailed within) at a C grade or higher
- Meet any additional entry requirements as listed on the relevant course webpage (e.g. prerequisites, audition, interviews or portfolio)
- If criteria are met, students must still apply via SATAC (for most courses) as normal, or direct via Flinders for the Sport Diplomas and Flinders Online courses.

Guaranteed Future Pathways

Successful completion of either Sports Management Diploma listed above provides guaranteed entry to the following courses (commence at Year 2):

- Bachelor of Business
- Bachelor of Business majoring in Sports Management
- Bachelor of Sport and Active Recreation.

As well as these guaranteed pathways, students completing either Sports Management Diploma will receive a Grade Point Average (GPA) allowing them to apply for transfer into other courses, such as the B Health Sciences / M Physiotherapy.
